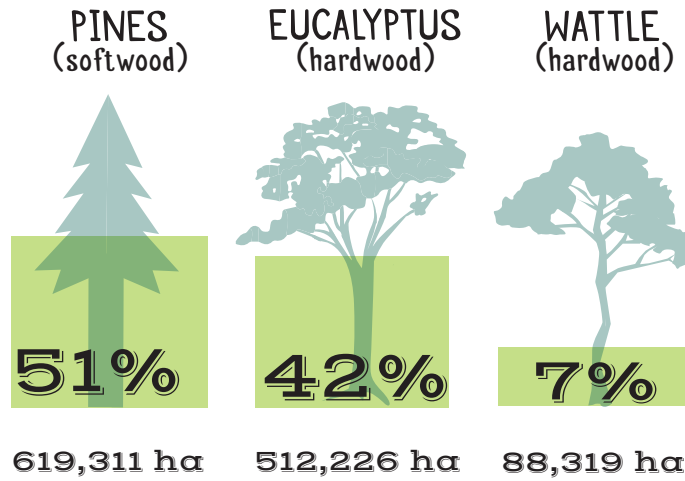


TIMBER PLANTATIONS GETTING TO KNOW THE TREES

99.7% is made up of **3 MAIN GENERA**



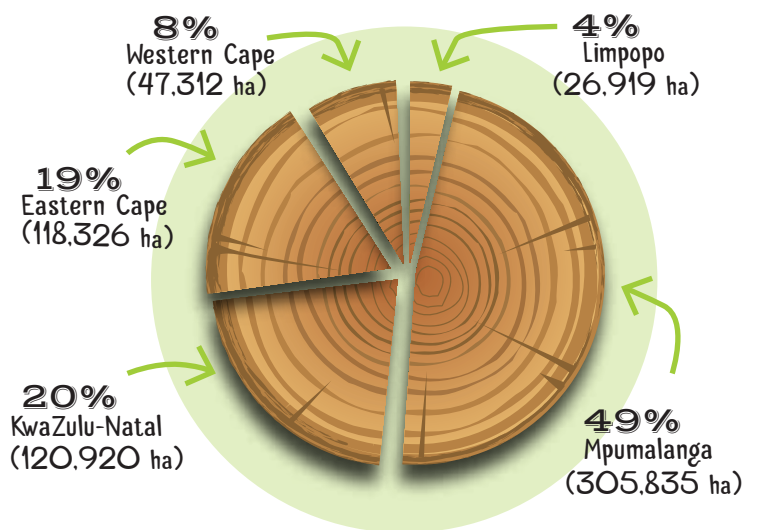
